Speakers that fail to sign up in advance and sign in at least 15 minutes before the meeting will not be called to speak. At the outset of Public Comment/Citizen Participation (about 5:00 p.m.), speakers that properly signed up in advance will be called forward individually and allowed to address the Board.
