## Garbage Collection by Best Trash within Reid Road MUD No. 1

On each regularly scheduled collection day, Wednesday and Saturday, Best Trash will collect residential refuse located curbside in Best Trash-supplied sixty-five (65) gallon roll out carts. All carts will remain the property of Best Trash and will be maintained, at no charge, by Best Trash. Residents are encouraged to confine their waste to the cart; however, waste collection service is not exclusively limited to the use of the cart. Any residential refuse not contained within the cart will be serviced as long as it is contained in additional containers between 30-50 gallons in size or bagged not heavier than 40 lbs.

Tree, shrub and brush trimmings must be bundled in lengths no greater than four (4) feet and weighing less than forty (40) pounds and branches with a maximum diameter of three (3) inches and placed at the curb. This excludes any waste generated as a result of force majeure.

As part of normal collection, Best Trash does not pick up dirt, rocks, bricks, concrete or any materials or items deemed hazardous materials or waste generated by a private contractor.

Bulky waste will be picked up on either scheduled day and must also be located at the curb. Refrigerators and freezers must be drained of Freon and have a bill to validate such service was performed.

For special collection other than normal amounts of residential refuse, yard trimmings or bulk items, if notified in advance, Best Trash will meet with the resident prior to collection day to negotiate a price. If a resident does not notify Best Trash of such a special pick-up before their scheduled day, then Best Trash will leave a notice for the resident to contact Best Trash during normal office hours before their next scheduled pick-up day. Payment for any special collection is the sole responsibility of the individual resident requesting same and is not an obligation of Reid Road MUD No. 1.

All carts, after being emptied by Best Trash, will be returned to their point of origin in the same condition in which they were taken, normal wear and tear excepted.

Best Trash will clean up spillage that occurs during the collection process; provided, however, that if liquid items in a garbage container are not seen by Best Trash personnel resulting in spillage that causes a stain, Best Trash will not be responsible.

Best Trash will provide residents of the District with one (1) sixty-five (65) gallon roll out cart per home. Best Trash will replace any carts that are defective or otherwise become unusable due to normal wear and tear. Residents may contact Best Trash if they have a lid that breaks, if the body gets cracked, or if a wheel is missing, etc. Lost or stolen carts, or carts damaged beyond normal wear and tear, will be replaced for \$85.00 with such fee paid by the resident or property owner.
